**Directions to venue from the Crop Science Building**

- From front (North) entrance of the Crop Science Bldg. proceed due North, crossing the street (Campus Way). You are now facing the Food Science Building.
- Turn left (West) and proceed ~ 40 steps.

- Turn right (North) and proceed ~ 70 steps. There will be a greenhouse on your left; the and the Food Science Bldg. (and a refrigerated shipping container) will be on your right.
- Turn left into the main greenhouse corridor (massive rolling door).
- Turn right into the first hallway (“Wing 16”).
- You will have arrived!

**Parking:**

- There are parking lots to the West and South of the Crop Science Building. There is an electronic kiosk where you can buy a parking pass (\$7.00 all day ***but valid for student and visitor zones only***). Or you can come to the venue and get a parking pass (alas, \$7.00) valid for all zones (including faculty and staff). Finally, you can take your chances on free parking in the neighborhood to the North of the greenhouse. Orchard avenue between 35<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> is free, has no restrictions, and is usually full by 7:30 AM. Streets to the North of Orchard have 2 hr. restrictions.
