

An update on the New Brunswick buckwheat malter from Georges Corriveau, ing/ P. Eng

“It has been a while since we have given you feedback on our latest development with our 1 ton buckwheat malter. Since September we have produced 9 batches of malt and have submitted samples to the Community College labs for analysis. We have also distributed some volumes to local microbreweries for a first experience. We have decided to put in place a quality control system before hitting the microbrewery market. For your information, the Community College we worked with for the design and fabrication of the unit was awarded a recognition last month by the Government in innovation and their contribution to the industry. Our malter was well promoted before the 600 audience attending the Gala. This is where we're at for the moment and are looking forward for the summer. We will have beer samples available and will then be able to meet with the industry with a high quality product. I never thought that this would be my retirement hobby but I find this pretty exciting! Once again, many thanks to your Oregon State University team who have been very supportive through our early days in this challenging project.”
